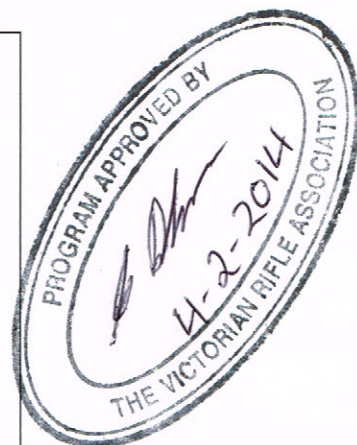
**Novelty Event** – Saturday, single shot (no sighters) at 1000 yards for a bottle of scotch – free entry.

#### FIRST VISIT TO ROSEDALE?
